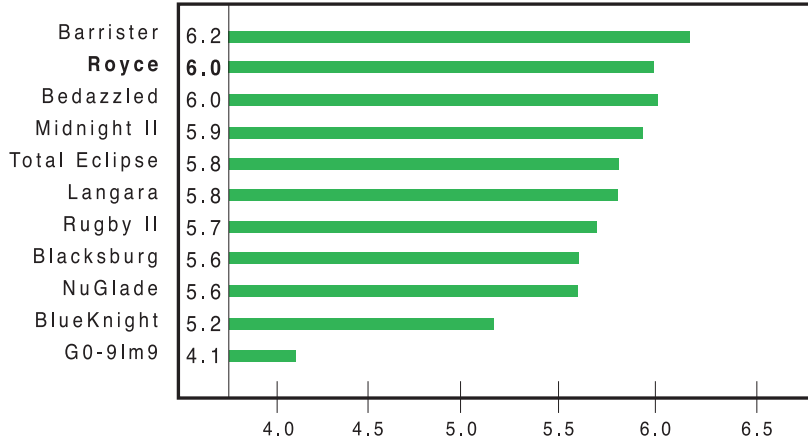

Royce Kentucky Bluegrass is a very fine bladed very dense variety that tillers aggressively to form a compact turf that endures heavy use and varying conditions of play. An excellent summer performer, Royce persists through periods of drought with improved resistance to troublesome diseases like red thread, dollar spot, and summer patch.

Royce retains its density in shaded areas as well. Royce is particularly suggested for sod production, sports turf and golf course usage where its aggressive tillering and compactness withstands scuffing and divots with less damage and is quicker to recuperate from any damage that does occur.



TURFGRASS QUALITY



Royce is a vigorous variety that is quick to establish and fill in. The stand retains its density under varying conditions with only normal fertility. In trials from New England to the Midwest, even down into the humid transition zone, Royce's quality is hard to beat.

NTEP Schedule C, 03-02. 1-9, 9 = highest quality. Selected varieties including highest and lowest.

Royce's fine texture and disease resistance, including powdery mildew, make it useful in blends intended for shaded areas where other bluegrasses would lack sufficient stand density for success.

1-9, 9 = shade tolerant. NTEP 03-2. Selected varieties including highest and lowest.

Royce exhibits a broad spectrum of disease resistance including dollar spot, red thread and summer patch. This trait allows for better density retention, contributing to overall quality.

1-9, 9 = no dollar spot. NTEP 03-2. Selected varieties including highest and lowest.

SEEDING For most applications, Royce should be sown at 2-4 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. or 100-175 lbs per acre. Consistent watering is very important until after the first cutting. Royce is ideal for renovating existing turf that has been damaged or thinned by disease or wear. Overseed at 1 1/2 to 2 1/2 lbs per 1000 sq. ft.

MAINTENANCE Royce is versatile, growing well in both full sun and partial shade, and under both high and low maintenance programs. Mow as necessary, removing no more than 1/3 of the leaf. Royce can be maintained at 1/2" height when adequate moisture and nutrients are available. As a minimum, fertilize annually with 2 to 3 lbs nitrogen per 1000 sq. ft. in a balanced formulation. More intensive programs produce a denser, more attractive turf.
