Black Pearl is a great choice for all your perennial ryegrass needs. Black Pearl is selected from improved genetics, providing a better breeding platform than most other varieties. Black Pearl is a very dark green variety, ranking in the top 3 entries of the recent NC State overseeding trial. In addition, Black Pearl scored in the top group for turf quality, having fine blades and excellent density. Black Pearl also establishes well, exhibiting good seedling vigor and providing green cover quickly.

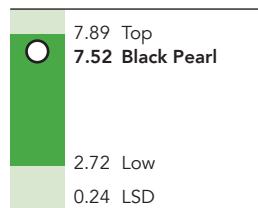

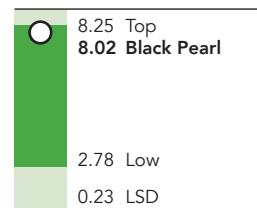

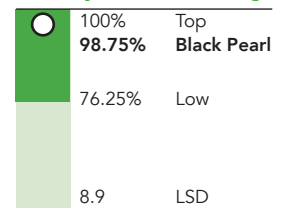
MEAN QUALITY

SEEDING

Black Pearl readily establishes on loosened bare soil or after verticutting existing turf for renovation and overseeding. For typical new seeding applications, apply at a rate of 5-7 lbs/1,000 sq ft. Periodic reseeding at 3-5 lbs/1,000 sq ft maintains density for visual appearance and durability. For overseeding dormant warm season grasses, a rate of 30-40 lbs/1,000 sq ft is suggested for golf course greens. And 7-10 lbs/1,000 sq ft (300-450 lbs/acre) for tees, fairways and roughs.

MAINTENANCE

Black Pearl will form a tight knit turf under a broad range of soil types and environmental conditions, from full sun to medium shade. It will mow cleanly at heights of 1/2" and above. Black Pearl can be maintained at fairway cutting heights when appropriate management practices are observed.
