SEEDING

Black Stallion readily establishes on loosened bare soil or after verticutting existing turf for renovation and overseeding. For typical new seeding applications, apply at a rate of 5-7 lbs per 1,000 sq ft. Periodic reseeding at 3-5 lbs per 1,000 sq ft maintains density for visual appearance and durability. For overseeding dormant warm season grasses, a rate of 30-40 lbs per 1,000 sq ft is suggested for golf course greens, and 7-10 lbs per 1,000 sq ft for tees, fairways and roughs.

MAINTENANCE

Black Stallion will form a tight knit turf under a broad range of soil types and environmental conditions, from full sun to medium shade. It will mow cleanly at heights of ½" and above. Due to its tillering ability and compact profile, Black Stallion can be maintained at fairway cutting heights when appropriate management practices are observed.
