

SEEDING AND OVERSEEDING Black Pearl readily establishes on loosened bare soil or after verticutting existing turf for renovation and overseeding. For typical new seeding applications, apply at a rate of 5-7 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Periodic reseeding at 3-5 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. maintains density for visual appearance and durability. For overseeding dormant warm season grasses, a rate of 30-40 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. is suggested for golf course greens. And 7-10 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (300-450 lbs. per acre) for tees, fairways and roughs.

MAINTENANCE Black Pearl will form a tight knit turf under a broad range of soil types and environmental conditions, from full sun to medium shade. It will mow cleanly at heights of 1/2" and above. Black Pearl can be maintained at fairway cutting heights when appropriate management practices are observed.
