Foreman Forage Bermudagrass Blend contains three specially selected forage and dual-purpose bermudagrass varieties with geographically diverse back grounds. The genetic diversity of this blend makes it adaptable to a wide range of regions and uses. Foreman contains a new dual-purpose variety Heritage, produced in the Western High Desert region of Eastern Oregon. Heritage is hearty and persistent with excellent winter hardiness to survive and green up the next spring. It is lateral growing and withstands close grazing with fine stems and excellent forage quality. Foreman also contains KF194, a time-tested forage type bermudagrass widely recommended in the Southeast. KF194 bermudagrass is produced in the Southwest and has the same winter hardiness, yield, persistence, and quality as Cheyenne and CD90160. Wrangler bermudagrass is developed and produced under the extreme growing conditions of the Southern High Plains. Wrangler has excellent winter hardiness and medium leaf texture with greater density than F-1 hybrids. Wrangler seeded bermudagrass yields like Midland and Tifton 44. The genetic diversity of this blend makes it widely adaptable and an excellent choice for hay, grazing, and soil conservation. Foreman bermudagrass is ideal for horses, cattle, and small ruminants.
